

Montana Cup standings

As of June 19, 2017

Following are the current amateur standings for the 2017 Montana Cup golf matches, based on events that began in August, 2016. They include the State Seniors, State Mid-Amateur, Kalispell Labor Day, Butte Labor Day, Montana Open, Gallatin Valley Open and Yellowstone County Amateurs in 2016, and several PGA Pro-Am tournaments in both the Western Montana and Yellowstone chapters through June 19, 2017. It also includes the first five events of 2017, the Lake City Open, Ben Graham Memorial, Barnett Memorial, State Match Play, Old Works Amateur and Oilfield Invitational.

The qualification process has been altered for 2016-17 to include three extra tournaments (the Ben Graham Memorial in Libby, and Labor Day events in both Butte and Kalispell). The points awarded for each of the 16 tourneys also has been simplified, giving points (50 down to 10) for only the top five finishers. The points awarded to Pro-Am winners has been increased to 30 for first place and 20 for second.

The current qualification period began Aug. 1, 2016 and will conclude with the Whitefish Lake Fourth of July tourney in 2017. The top 12 players (aged 21 and over) are eligible to compete at the 2017 Montana Cup.
