

Montana Cup standings

As of September 14, 2017

Following are the current amateur standings for the 2018 Montana Cup golf matches, based on events that began in July, 2017. They include the State Amateur, USGA Amateur Qualifier, State Seniors, State Mid-Amateur, Labor Day tourneys in Butte and Kalispell, plus the Montana Open and Gallatin Valley Open. They also include the Pro-Am events following the Whitefish Lake Fourth of July tournament through Sept. 11.

The qualification process was altered in 2017 to include three extra tournaments (the Ben Graham Memorial in Libby, and Labor Day events in both Butte and Kalispell). The points awarded for each of the 16 tourneys also has been simplified, giving points (50 down to 10) for only the top five finishers. The points awarded to Pro-Am winners has been increased to 30 for first place and 20 for second.

The current qualification period began July 10, 2017 and will conclude with the Whitefish Lake Fourth of July tourney in 2018. The top 12 players (aged 21 and over) are eligible to compete at the 2018 Montana Cup.
