#### FEES

Entry fee is \$225. Cart fee is \$48 (1 seat, 3 days). No club storage will be provided.

#### ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur male players, whose residence is in the state of Montana, are members of the MSGA, and have a current Handicap Index® of 10.0 or less (State Am) or 15.0 or less (Sr/Super Sr). Entrants for the Senior Am must be at least 55 years old and for the Super Sr Am at least 65 years old by the first day of the championship.

#### TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Stroke Play. Players will be flighted by Handicap Index®: 54-hole tournament played at Scratch. Yardage ranges by division: State Am 7000-7400 yds, Senior Am 6800-7200 yds, and Super Sr Am 6400-6800 yds. Field size is State Am - 104, Senior Am - 48, and Super Sr Am - 40.

#### PRACTICE ROUND AND CHECK IN

Player is responsible for cost of practice round, cart, and range balls, available for a nominal fee. Beginning June 19, you may

call (406) 563-5989 to schedule your practice round. Players will check in at Old Works GC on July 12.

#### REGULATIONS, PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Distance measuring devices are permitted per USGA Local Rule (Decision 14-3/0.5). No metal or ceramic spikes permitted. Players are required to wear proper golf attire.

#### PUSH CARTS AND CADDIES

Push carts and caddies are allowed. But, no extra seat in the cart for caddie, unless empty seat is available and paid for at the club.

#### RULES OF COMPETITION

The USGA Rules of Golf will govern play. The MSGA Tournament Committee, whose decision will be final, will settle questions. The competition will be deemed closed when the winners' awards have been presented. The lowest 54-hole score in the State Am, Senior Am, and Super Sr Am divisions will be the 2023 Champions. Awards will be presented in all flights. Ties will be settled using the Modified USGA (18,9,6,3,1) method. A Rules sheet will be provided.

#### SCHEDULE

Thursday, July 13: 1st round - 18 holes; Friday, July 14: 2nd round - 18 holes; Saturday, July 15: Final round - 18 holes; Awards presentation following competition.

#### BY APPLYING, YOU AGREE:

You are aware of and meet the eligibility requirements as listed on this form.
