ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur female players, whose residence is in the state of Montana, are members of the MSGA, and have a current handicap index of 40.0 or less. Entrants for the Mid Am must be at least 30 years old and entrants for the Senior Am must be at least 55 years old, by the first day of the championship.

FEES

Entry fee is \$200, which includes player banquet & party. Cart fee is \$45, Club storage fee is \$10. Any guest social fee will be paid at the event.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Stroke Play. Amateur, Mid Am, and Senior Amateur Divisions will play from various tees. Players will be flighted by handicap index, 54-hole tournament played at Scratch.

REGULATIONS, PERSONAL APPEARANCE

Distance measuring devices are permitted per USGA Local Rule (Decision 14-3/0.5). No metal or ceramic spikes permitted. Players are required to wear proper golf attire. Blue jeans, halter tops, tank tops, tube tops, and spaghetti straps are not permitted.

RULES OF COMPETITION

The USGA Rules of Golf will govern play. The MSGA Tournament Committee, whose decision will be final, will settle questions. The competition will be deemed closed when the winners' awards have been presented. The lowest 54-hole score in the Amateur, Mid-Am, and Senior Amateur divisions will be the 2021 Champions. Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd places in all flights. All ties will be settled using the USGA tie-breaking formula.

PRACTICE ROUND

One complimentary practice round will be available. Beginning July 12, you may call 406-454-3553 to schedule your practice round. Player is responsible for cart fee during practice round. Range balls will be complimentary.

SCHEDULE

Thursday, July 29: 1st round - 18 holes; 7pm Special Event. Friday, July 30: 2nd round - 18 holes; 7pm Special Event. Saturday, July 31: Final round - 18 holes; Awards presentation following competition.

REGISTRATION

Player registration at Meadow Lark Country Club will open July 28.
